


**William Hurry's Grave.**

sexton of the Pine Street Presbyterian church, Philadelphia, found the tombstone originally erected at the head of his grave. It had become half buried in moss and undergrowth. The local chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution became interested, and a suitable monument is at last to be erected over the resting place of the man who rang out the glad news of the birth of a new nation.
